The Boys Dorm

Covid brought on some unexpected delays in the construction of the Boys Dorm in 2020 but our site stayed active throughout the year. The mumty (staircase tower) roof was poured on August 31 marking the substantial completion of the structural concrete and steel frame. Throughout the summer and fall, exterior and interior masonry walls were erected, electrical and plumbing roughs-ins completed, and most of the ceiling and walls were plastered. We closed out the year with the installation of the atrium roof on December 29. The construction team made a valiant effort to make up for lost time in Q4 of 2020 and we are on track to complete the project in 2021. We have raised \$763,176 towards the project and are currently reforecasting the estimate to complete. Thank you all for your support and for journeying with us to turn this dream into a reality!

Notes

- Revenues specifically for post secondary education were collected in 2020 but were combined with operations in 2019
- There was a surplus of post secondary education in 2020 which will be applied to 2021 post secondary education in 2021
- 3. There were no missions and annual construction projects in 2020 due to Covid 19
- 4. Boys Dorm expenses in 2020 were less than expected because of Covid 19 limiting construction at the home. It has re-started in earnest early in the fall of 2020 with anticipated completion by summer of 2021 provided sufficient funds are available.
